

Lake of the Pines Association Pool Monitor – Seasonal Position

Lake of the Pines Homeowners Association (LOP) is accepting applications for the position of Pool Monitor. We are looking for qualified applicants for our 2018 spring and summer seasons for the months of March - October. Lake of the Pines is a 2,000-home gated private community located in the foothills of Northern California between the towns of Auburn and Grass Valley. This is a Seasonal position with a salary range of \$11.00 - \$12.00 an hour. Pre-employment drug screen and background search (if applicable) required following conditional offer of employment.

Essential duties and Responsibilities:

- Responsible for cleanliness of facility and patron safety including enforcing the swimming pool rules, opening and closing the facility, basic emergency response, provide First Aid and following all local and county rules and regulations.
- Observe daily sanitation requirements by checking pool water conditions for chlorine and PH (acidity) content as prescribed. Notify supervisor if chemicals are not within limits.
- Maintain daily log of pool water test conditions for the inspection of local health agency.
- Records and inputs pool attendance sheets daily into computer system.
- In the event of equipment breakdown or malfunction, or unsafe water or general conditions, will close pool, apply proper procedures set forth and notify supervisor.
- Maintain the cleanliness and healthfulness of the restroom facility.
- Maintain storage room facility in a safe and orderly fashion.
- Install and remove lane lines and pool cover as necessary.

Required Skills/Qualifications:

- CPR and First Aid certification desired, but training available.
- Must be able to swim across the pool.
- Move/ lift a maximum of 50 lbs.
- Available at minimum from June – August but March – October desired.
- Minimum age: 15 years old with valid work permit
- Experience in Aquatics, babysitting, working with children, adults, and seniors desired.
- Familiar with Aquatic Programming
- Ability to work well independently with integrity and as a team.
- Basic Computer skills required.
