

## **Lake of the Pines Association Greenskeeper II/Mechanic – FT Position**

Lake of the Pines Homeowners Association (LOP) is accepting applications for the position of Greenskeeper and Golf Course Equipment Mechanic.

Lake of the Pines is a 2,000-home gated private community located in the foothills of Northern California between the towns of Auburn and Grass Valley. Among its numerous amenities, the community boasts of a 230-acre private lake and a 19-hole golf course as two of its prime amenities. This is a FT, hourly position with a salary range of \$13.80 - \$16.02 and excellent benefits including medical, dental, vision and life insurance; vacation and sick leave; 401k and facility use privileges including golf, swimming pool, beaches, parks, tennis and discounted meals. Pre-employment drug screen and background search required following conditional offer of employment.

### **Essential Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Operate tractor to till, cultivate, and grade new turf areas, apply prescribed amounts of lime, fertilizer, insecticide, and fungicide, and mow rough and fairway areas at designated cut. Mow, irrigate and perform general maintenance and clean up duties "daily".
- Change cups, rakes sand bunkers, relocate tee markers, and perform similar functions conducive to golf play "daily". Repair irrigation leaks, drainage ditches, and cart paths. Aerate and thatch as required. Prune trees and perform related landscaping operations conducive to golf play.
- Operate hand or power mower to cut turf on green and tee areas, light and heavy equipment and vehicles with a working knowledge of repair and maintenance.
- Connect hose and sprinkler systems at designated points on course to irrigate turf.
- Dig and rake ground to prepare new greens, grade and cleans trap, and repair roadbeds.
- Plant, trim, and spray trees and shrubs.
- Perform heavy manual labor and other duties as required.
- Inspects, diagnoses, adjusts and repairs mechanical defects/failures in various pieces of golf course maintenance equipment on a regular basis.
- Repair and maintain various gasoline and diesel-powered golf course maintenance equipment.
- Prioritizes equipment repair and maintenance work.
- Sets up and modifies new equipment as needed.
- Repairs and adjusts engines and cutting mechanisms on various heavy and light mowing equipment.
- Keeps maintenance equipment greased, oiled and inspected; and performs related tasks as required.

### **Required Skills/Qualifications:**

- High School Diploma or GED.
- 3 years related experience in golf course maintenance and as equipment mechanic
- Working knowledge of the general operation of gasoline-, diesel- and electric-powered equipment; the proper methods of servicing golf course equipment; and the repair and adjustment of power mowing equipment.
- Valid California Driver license in good standing.
- The employee must regularly lift and/or move up to 25 pounds, frequently lift and/or move up to 50 pounds, and occasionally lift and/or move up to 100 pounds with appropriate assistance.
- Open Availability including early mornings, and some weekends and holidays required.
