RULES & REGULATIONS**



Golf Cart Rules

Golf carts are motorized vehicles and as such must obey all California Vehicle Codes.

1. Drivers must hold and have in possession a valid driver's license.
2. Only the driver and one passenger are allowed in golf carts other than for those golf carts specifically designed to carry an additional two passengers in a rear seat.
3. Golf carts must obey all speed limits.
4. Golf carts must obey all traffic signs including, but not limited to STOP, YIELD, DO NOT ENTER, NO LEFT TURN AND ONE-WAY SIGNS.
5. Golf carts operating between the hours of sunset and sunrise must have working headlights and taillights.
6. Golf carts must yield to pedestrians.
7. Valid LOP decals for street operation and/or golf course use must be placed on the driver's and passenger's sides in the area indicated below. The decal must be visible when using a cart enclosure. Failure to do so could result in the owner receiving an unregistered cart citation, which carries a fine as outlined in the LOP Schedule of Fines. Decals for previous years must be removed or covered over. Only the current decal may be displayed.

Golf carts used on the golf course must have approved turf tires and all golf course rules must be obeyed.

8. Carts must drive on the right side of the street; the same as cars.

State registered slow speed vehicles with valid license plates do not require LOP registration unless used on the golf course.

Although the following are recommended, they are not required in Lake of the Pines:

1. Seat belts
2. Turn signals
3. Windshield wipers
4. Rear view mirrors
5. Brake lights
