



# Lake of the Pines Association Policies & Procedures

*This policy is not an Operating Rule as defined in the Davis-Stirling Common Interest Development Act.*

## **Governmental/Community Affairs**

- A. The multiplicity of governmental/community entities that the Lake of the Pines Association deals with represents federal, state, county, city, special districts, school and a myriad of other community-based organizations.
- B. In order to effectively function, there is a need to designate at what level these interactions should take place and staff positions to be involved.
- C. The President of the Board of Directors or his/her designee and the General Manager and his/her designee are named to represent the Lake of the Pines Association in any and all dealings with federal, state, county, city and community-based entities.
- D. It is intended that participation include serving on elected/appointed boards of directors, commissions, committees, advisory bodies, etc. or in whatever capacity that is required to best represent the interests of LOP.
- E. The designated representatives of LOP shall meet regularly with the Board of Directors and General Manager to ensure that a comprehensive Governmental/Community Affairs Program is developed and accomplished. It is anticipated that a governmental/community affairs program to be effective would necessarily involve the following entities:
